# Goals

- Build on Network Visioning efforts
- Enhance each Program's capacity to address their 2018-2021 strategic plans
- Advance the priority actions identified in the “network visioning” plans
- Specifically support efforts to advance DEI and TLK activities

# Mechanism Basics

- \$1.4 million of FY 2019 funds
- Institutional awards
- Due May 23, 2019 in grants.gov
- One award of up to \$40,000 in federal funds
- Added to omnibus
- 50% non-fed match required
- May stretch across two years (Sep 2019-Sep 2021)



# Guidelines

Articulate the specific actions they will take to implement one or more priority actions identified in one or more of the “network visioning” documents



# Guidelines

Funds may be used for research, extension, education, communications, or administrative activities in support of these efforts.



# Guidelines

Coordination and collaboration with other programs or communities of practice encouraged but not required



# Guidelines

25% of requested federal funds must be used to advance DEI or TLK initiatives

- Specifics are flexible
- Start new or enhance existing efforts



# Guidelines

For all proposed work, Environmental Literacy goals should be considered as incorporated as appropriate.

- 90-2 short form
- Abbreviated Environmental Compliance Questionnaire (NEPA)
- Data Mgmt Plan
- 90-4 form
- Budget narrative
- Other required forms: SF424, SF424A, SF424B, CD511
