

## **NSGO liaisons for 2017 Sea Grant Network Visioning projects**

The role of your NSGO liaison is to:

- Empower the network to build these visions;
- Act as a participant in the conversations;
- Make sure that there is consistency in the products across the visioning topics;
- Maintain and encourage a National Level focus for these topics, ie. make sure that they are not getting regionally/state specific;
- Provide National level insights, especially as it relates to focus areas and the three pillars of Sea Grant;
- Help make connections (especially at high levels) that may be useful;
