B.2 - Major accomplishments

Fellows should prepare a summary list of accomplishments for the given reporting period. Fellows are encouraged to use the accomplishments list as developed as part of their professional development plan. Accomplishments may include work and educational milestones and should cover any significant results (both positive and challenges) and key outcomes or achievements. All reported accomplishments should be completed while on duties as a Knauss fellow. No more than two pages, may be a bulleted list.

B.4 - Training and professional development

Fellows should prepare a summary list of professional development and training for the given reporting period.
